## Why we need your help:

Able Hands Together is offering a new family service which concentrates on families who have one or more children with ASD and / or ADHD. The intention will be for families to work as equals together on projects around the farm as a bonding experience. Each family will be offered a 30-minute session with our life coach who will work through a tool kit developed by a child psychologist. We are looking for someone who understands disability and family benefits who can support / signpost any families who are struggling to access the benefits they need.

## What we need you to bring to the organisation:

- Ability to work as part of a team.
- Approachable and good at listening.
- An understanding of disability / family benefits
- Self-motivation.
