Why we need your help:

Able Hands Together is offering a new family service which concentrates on families who have one or more children with ASD and / or ADHD. The intention will be for families to work as equals together on projects around the farm as a bonding experience. Each family will also be offered a 30-minute session with our life coach who will work through a tool kit developed by a child psychologist. We are looking for someone who can work alongside families during these days and support the families to carry out activities around the farm.

- Ability to work as part of a team.
- Approachable and good at listening to the whole family
- Self-motivation.

What we can offer you:

- The opportunity to gain skills and experience within a supportive and professional team.
- To become part of the farm family.
- Regular support from your line manager.

- To be able to provide a non-judgemental approach and to ensure boundaries are maintained.
- To follow Able Hands Together's policies and procedures
- To complete documentation relating to the role.
- To be able to complete given tasks.
- To undertake any training required.
